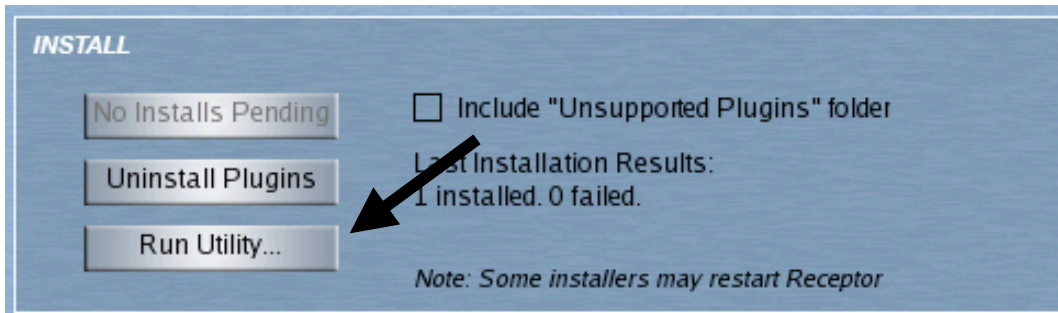
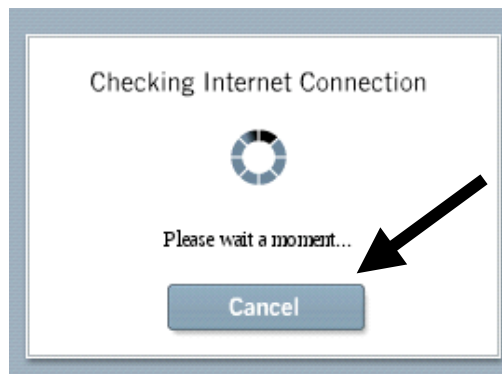


How To Authorize a Native Instruments Plug-in On Receptor using Service Center

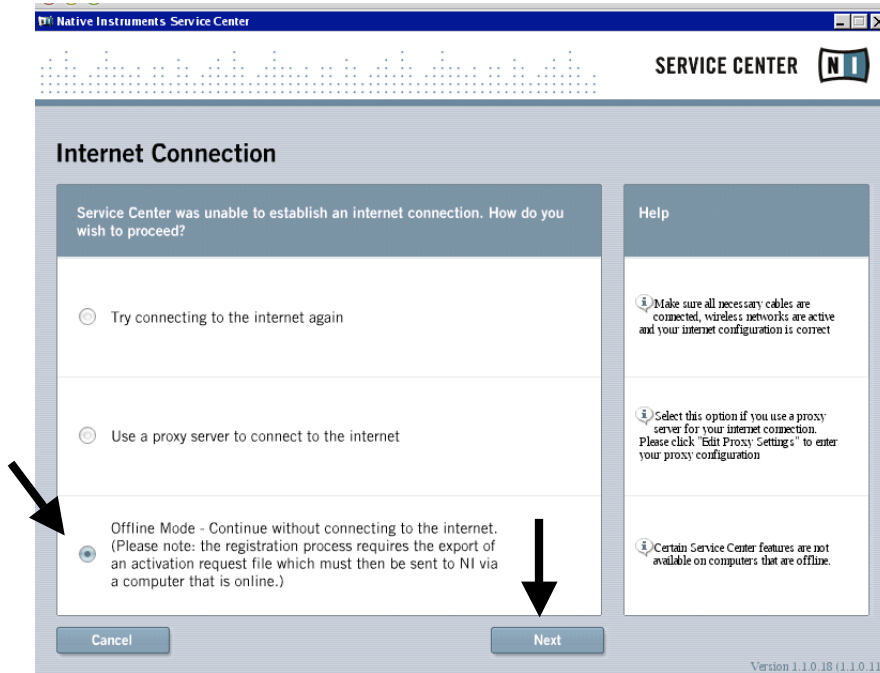
1. Open up the Receptor graphical user interface and click on the SETUP tab. Located the “Run Utility” button in the INSTALL section of the SETUP page. Select SERVICE CENTER from the “**Run Utility...**” drop down menu.



2. Click on the "CANCEL" button when the application checks for the Internet Connection.




3. From the Internet Connection window select "Offline Mode" and click on "NEXT".
- NOTE: It will say "All installed products are activated" if the plug-ins / bundles are already activated. If not, it will list the plug-ins/bundles that require activation.*



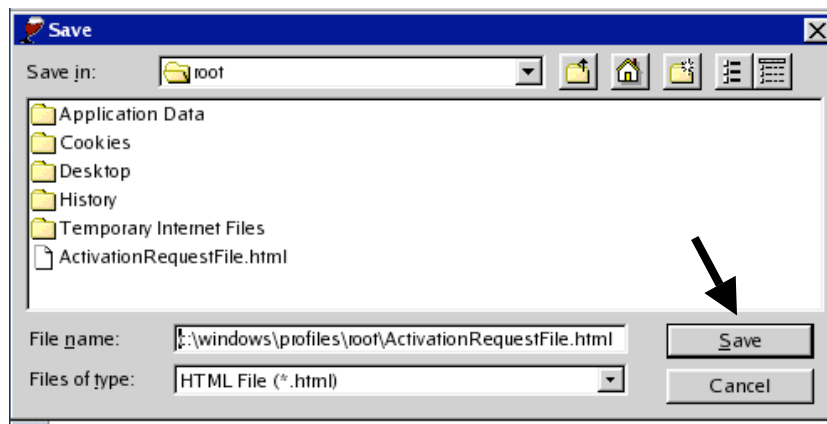
4. Select the products you wish to authorize by checking the box to the right. You can authorize more than one product at a time with Service Center. Once you've selected the products you wish to authorize, click "Next".



5. Enter the serial numbers for the products you wish to enter. It is essential that you enter in the serial number EXACTLY as it appears on your serial number card. Double check your entry, and then click on the “Export” button to save the activation request file.

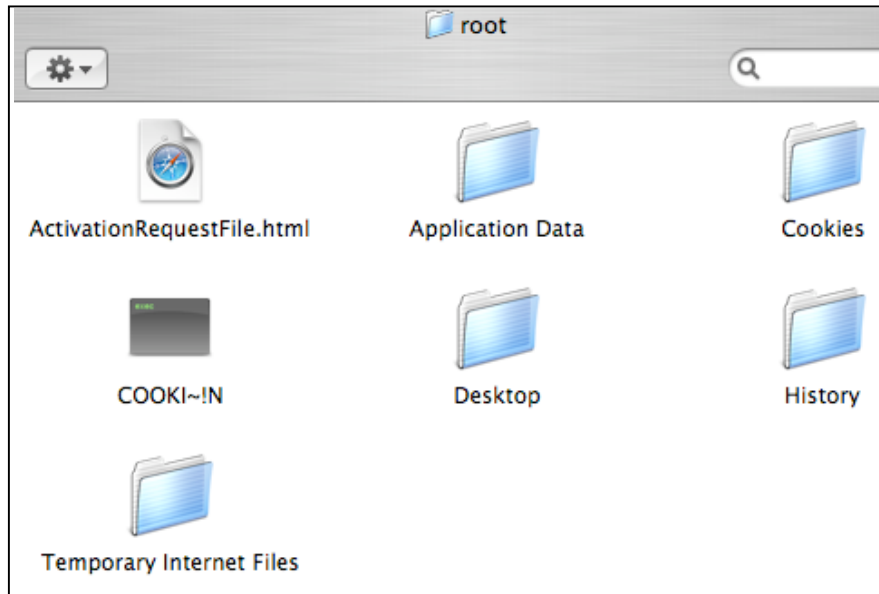


6. Click the Save button at which point the *Activation Request File* will be saved to the Receptor in the path: <Receptor Hard Drive>:/windows/profiles/root



7. Open the Receptor hard drive from your computer.

8. Open the folder under <Receptor Hard Drive>/windows/profiles/root



9. Copy the *ActivationRequestFile.html* file to your computer Desktop and double click it to take you to the Native Instruments registration site online.

*NOTE: If the Receptor drive is mounted on your computer's desktop, and your computer is connected to the Internet at the same time, you can just double click the *ActivationRequestFile.html* file on the mounted Receptor drive.*



10. Select the "SEND" button to transmit the request to the Native Instruments server.

NI Service Center Product Activation


Welcome to the Native Instruments Offline Activation process. Please follow the step-by-step instructions to activate your product:

1. Please save this "Activation Request" file as a HTML file onto a portable medium.
Select FILE -> SAVE FILE AS... in the main menu of your browser. Then save the "Activation Request" file onto a USB stick or other portable medium.
2. Transfer the file to a computer with internet access.
3. Go online.
4. Open the file in your browser.
5. Please click on the button below. The NI registration page will open. Please follow the on-screen instructions. If you do not have an NI product account you will be prompted to create one.
6. Save the resulting "Activation Verification" file back onto your portable medium
7. Transfer back to the computer with your Native Instruments products.
8. Open the NI Service Center and import the "Activation Verification" file. The NI Service Center opens automatically with the import dialogue.
9. Your product has now been successfully activated.

11. Log in to your NI user account and click "Next" to generate the *Activation Return File*.

Creating your Activation Return Files

You logged in successfully with your login data. The record of your Activation Request Files was successfully transferred to the Native Instruments webserver.

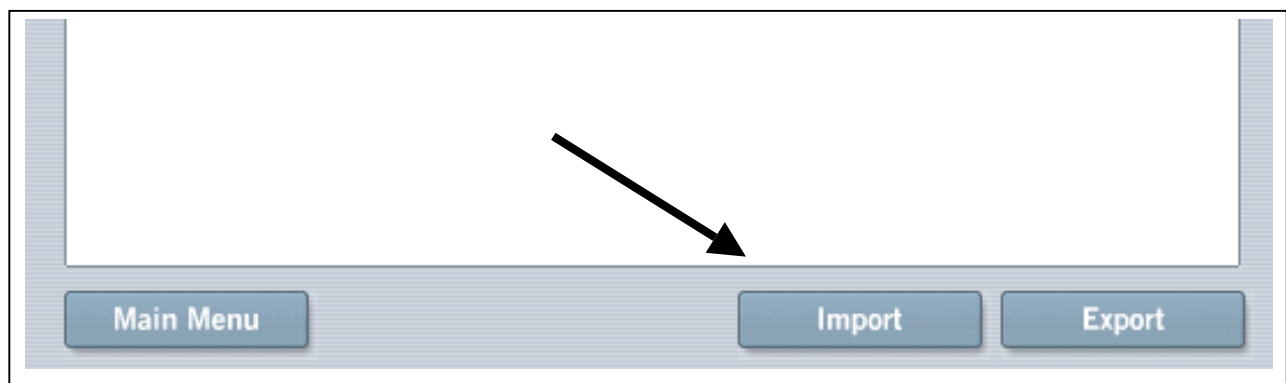
Please click on the "Next" button to create the corresponding Activation Return File.

12. Click "Next" to download the authorization file.

13. Copy the *ActivationReturnFile.naf* to the Receptor's Hard Drive by dragging it to the hard drive (don't put it in any folder, just keep it on the main drive desktop)

14. Now back on your Receptor's graphical interface, click on the "Import" button on the Service Center application, browse to the folder C: and select the Activation Return File to authorize your plug-ins / bundles.



15. The Service Center should report "Products successfully activated" upon which the plug-ins / bundles are removed from the list of products for activation in the NI Service Center.
16. Close the NI Service Center by clicking the **X** in the top right hand corner of the window.
17. Instantiate the plug-in, and enjoy the power of Native Instruments software!
